

## Using *Plateau Student Access*

---



The **Plateau Student Access** is a part of the **Plateau 4 LMS** that comes standard with **Plateau Administrator**. Most of the tasks you will be performing in **Plateau Student Access** are based on the permissions you are granted in **Plateau Administrator** by your learning administrator . It is important to note that the system may not allow you to perform all of the tasks documented in the help system. In most cases, what you see is a function of the permissions you have been granted. If you have specific needs, you may want to refer to your learning administrator to grant you permissions accordingly.
