SUBJECT: Overtime

Effective September 20, 1981, the following actions are authorized for the Federal Aviation Administration only:

1. The definition of "regularly scheduled overtime", contained in the Department of Transportation (DOT) Order 3600.5A, Departmental Policy on the Use of Fractional Hours, is changed to:

"Work which is scheduled in advance for performance by an employee to recur on at least three days, either successive or after specified intervals."

2. DOT Order 3550.1, Departmental Policy on the Use of Compensatory Time Off in Lieu of Paid Overtime requires: a) a maximum cut-off level of 80 hours for the accumulation of compensatory time; and b) a time limitation for the use of accumulated compensatory time. Both of these requirements are waived.
